

A Window Into Upkeep

How many windows are there on the entirety of the church campus? How many air conditioning units do we have? How old is the roof? These are the sorts of things that I had not

pondered prior to becoming your Junior Warden. These sorts of things have come to my attention now that I am charged with their upkeep.

Our church is astoundingly beautiful and it always evokes strong spiritual and emotional responses whenever I enter into the Nave. However, our church is much more than that. We are also blessed with a wonderful Chapel, All Saint's Hall, Parish Hall, a Choir room, a room utilized by

Narcotics Anonymous, the church offices, the playground, the nursery and downstairs, the upstairs Sunday school rooms and myriad other portions of the property. Our Parish Administrator, Joane Mackey, does a wonderful job of monitoring the premises and keeping things in order and notifies me whenever there are maintenance issues.

While we have not had to undertake a large project such as the removal of the carpet and the staining of our beautiful hardwood floors in my tenure, we have had a number of things that have required maintenance. For one, most all of the windows in and around the church have serious rot that set in due to water exposure. Most of these windows have been

caulked and painted and now look wonderful. However, this solved the symptoms, but not the underlying cause — the need to have our gutters

replaced. We have lined up a complete replacement of the gutters in and around the Nave so that they will be industrial grade gutters, which will prevent the intrusion of water into the walls and, in some instances, into the church. This will be done in the next 6 to 8 weeks.

The other big upcoming project is renovations to the rectory. Imagine living in a house that has had no substantive changes in decades. While routine

maintenance and occasional repairs have had to be made, there are some needed updates that will be beneficial not only to our current and future rectors, but will appreciate the value of the rectory.

It takes a lot to keep our Parish going, and we are fortunate to be in the position that we are in keeping up our church. I hope that, when the time comes to consider giving amounts in the future, you will take into consideration the needs of the campus and the rectory. Always feel free to contact me if you see anything that needs repairs, so that we might timely fix the problem.

A Southern Accent in Spain





When Fr. Austin reached Santiago de Compostela in Spain, he stayed at the Anglican Pilgrim Center in the middle of the city. He was then asked to serve at the Anglican Eucharist at the Chapel of Santa Anna. The service was held for an Anglican school group who had just finished walking the final portion of the Camino that very day. The Very Rev. Dr. Robert Willis, retired Dean of Canterbury Cathedral, presided. It was the first time in five weeks Fr. Austin heard the words we hear every week at God's table in English. It was also probably the first time young people from England heard holy scripture read with a southern accent.
